Bike Programme for Senior Students

Some interesting facts before getting on the bike

- **A** Air, check the tyre pressure
- **B** Brake, check how well the brakes are operating
- C Chain, check the tension on chain
- Q Quick Release, refers to releasing the wheels and seat

The 5 Ls - Left (stand next to the bike opposite to the road to avoid traffic; Levers (check the bike is in working order); Lean (put the bike on an angle so that you can get on); Look (don't forget to look behind); Leg over (a safe and sure way to get on your bike)

Reflections from students about their experiences

Ezra (Room 12) - I learnt how to do hand signals safely i.e. Left hand out and turn, right hand out and turn. Keahiwairua - (Room 16) - I learnt how important it was to apply equal pressure on the brakes to avoid flipping the bike or losing control.

Vincent - I learnt how to check my bike helmet, look for cracks, and know how to adjust the straps. Use two fingers placed on your forehead to check the helmet is the right fit and does not impede your vision.
